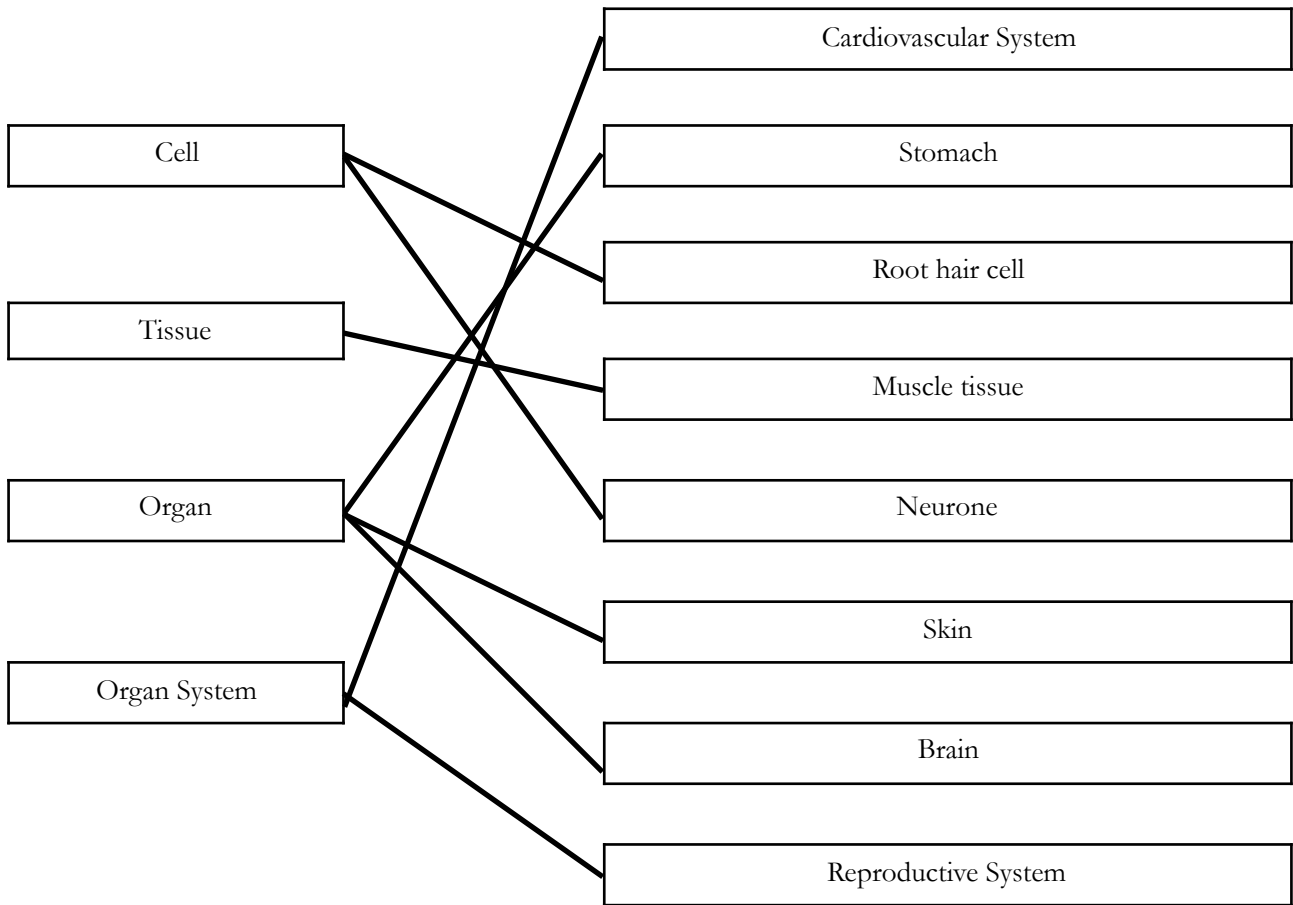
4 Name 4 organs in the digestive system
