The Exam:

There is 1 external exam (25% of total grade) that lasts 1 hour. Total of 60 marks

Contemporary issues in sport:

- LO1-Understanding the issues that affect participation in sport.
- LO2-Know about the role of sport and promoting values.
- LO3-Understanding the importance of hosting major sporting events.
- LO4-Know about the roles of National Governing Bodies in Sport.

Course Overview:

- 4 units (each are 25% of total grade).
- 3 are internally assessed based on practical skills and assignments (RO52, RO53 & RO54).

· 1 is assessed through external exam (RO51).

Units Covered:

- RO51 – Contemporary issues in sport (external exam 1 hour —60 marks).
- RO52 – Developing sports skills (Practical and assignment based assessment) - Students must be assessed in 1 team sport, 1 individual sport and officiating another sport.
- RO53 – Sports leadership (assignment and practical assessment).
- RO54 – Sports and the media (Assignment).
